

Drawer Removal Instructions

The full-extension, ball-bearing drawer glides that are used on many of our cases are not only designed for a consistent smooth opening and closing of the drawers, but also for safety. Each drawer has a set of drawer glides that do not allow the drawer to be removed unless a two-step operation is performed. This helps to prevent small children from being hurt by accidently pulling out a drawer.

Here is a plastic lever that needs to be depressed on the drawer glide on each side of the drawer.





When the end of the plastic lever is pointing down, then move your finger towards the back of that lever and depress it down.





When the end of the plastic lever is pointing up, then move your finger towards the back of that lever and depress it up.
